

DECISION

Re: Our Request Number: MAG-A-2021-00611

This is in response to your request under the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act (the Act) for access to:

- "Any records in the possession, custody or control of Doug Downey or the office of the Attorney General that:
- prove or evidence (via ownership, contract or consent) that the "rules of civil procedure" (that were promulgated by a private society/corporation) apply to, or, have jurisdiction over, i, Christine Anne of the Massey family (a flesh and blood woman), or to any man, woman or child (versus "persons"/corporations), and/or
- 2. prove or evidence (via ownership, contract or consent) that any man or woman has the right to block or prevent i, Christine Anne of the Massey family (a flesh and blood woman), or any other man or woman, from accessing a public courthouse to seek the administration of justice and move claim and court, (as clarified on December 31, 2021)."

Please be advised a search for records was conducted and no responsive records were located. Parts 1 and 2 of the request are not framed as a request for information but instead ask the Ministry to address a legal argument concerning jurisdiction of the Rules of Civil Procedure and access to the courts with respect to "a flesh and blood woman". In effect, the request asks the Ministry to justify the rule of law and the Ministry is not able to give legal advice.

Hi Clare,

The letter is not accurate where it states:

"Parts 1 and 2 of the request are not framed as a request for information but instead ask the Ministry to address a legal argument concerning jurisdiction of the Rules of Civil procedure and access to the courts with respect to "a flesh and blood woman". In effect, the request asks the Ministry to justify the rule of law and the Ministry is not able to give legal advice."

This is blatantly false as both parts of my communication were worded:

"Any records in the possession, custody or control of Doug Downey or the office of the Attorney General that... prove or evidence...."

I clearly sought **records**, not legal advice. I have no interest whatsoever in receiving legal advice as it would be irrelevant to a flesh and blood woman with God-given rights. And if I ever did want legal advice, the Ministry is probably the last place I would look for it.

It seems clear to me that these false statements were inserted into the letter in order to distract from the admission that there are no such records:

"Please be advised a search for records was conducted and no responsive records were located".

And it seems clear to me that if Josephine's false statements were true, Josephine would never have provided the above admission. Her admission would be nonsensical if I had been asking for legal advice and not records.

Thank you. I will now make this public.
